



### **TITLE VI NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC**

The City of San Marcos operates its programs and services in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and all related acts and statutes (Title VI). Title VI and related statutes prohibiting discrimination in Federally assisted programs require that no person in the United States of America shall, on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability be excluded from the participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal assistance. Any person who believes she or he has been aggrieved by any unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI may file a grievance with the City of San Marcos. Any such grievance must be in writing and submitted to the City's Title VI Compliance Officer within one hundred and eighty (180) days following the date of the alleged occurrence.
