



NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORKSHOP

PROJECT: Mission 24 Townhomes (GPA18-0003, R18-0003, TSM18-0002, MFSDP18-0002, and V18-0001)

BACKGROUND:

The City of San Marcos is currently processing a request to change the General Plan land use and zoning designations of 1210 E. Mission Road (i.e. the former bank building) from Neighborhood Commercial (NC) to Medium Density Residential 2 (MDR2)/R-3-10 to redevelop the site with 24 condominium (“townhome”) units. The project would consist of 4 two-story buildings, onsite parking, improvements to Avenida Chapala along the project frontage to allow parking on both side of the street and also a variance to reduce the Mission Road building setback to be consistent with existing development in the vicinity of the project site.

On February 21, 2019 at 6:00 PM, the City will be hosting a Public Workshop for residents to learn more about the project from the applicant and provide feedback. As a courtesy, this Notice of Public Workshop was mailed with the Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration. Please note that these notices are required by local ordinance and State law, and are sent at the expense of the project applicant. Residents will subsequently receive 2 additional notices for the project: A Notice of Public Hearing for the Planning Commission and an additional Notice of Public Hearing for the City Council.
