**2020 HOURS of WORK and HOLIDAY SCHEDULE**

The City of San Marcos Municipal Code specifies restrictions for times of construction and grading operations. Below are those restrictions, a holiday calendar, and important notes to assist you with the scheduling of your project.

**SMMC Section 17.08.080 Hours of Work: Construction related activities**

Monday through Friday 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Saturdays 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

**No work on Sunday or City Holidays**

**SMMC Section 17.32.180 Grading Operation Restrictions**

Monday through Friday 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

No warm up or maintenance/repair creating noise outside of hours noted above

**No work on Saturdays, Sundays and City Holidays**

**Important Notes:**

1. City Hall is closed on alternating Fridays beginning January 10, 2020.
2. Holidays not listed and closed Fridays are considered workdays.
3. To obtain an exemption from the above restrictions, submit a written request to the Building Safety Division 10 days prior to the proposed work date. Decision will be based on need and/or benefit to public.
4. Violations of Title 17 are subject to citations. Subsequent violations will result in suspension of permits and Stop Work Notices until a program is submitted to the City demonstrating full compliance with City Ordinances.
5. Avoid when possible, grading and construction in the right-of-way during the months of November and December in commercial / retail areas.
